The Market

UAE

The building construction industry in United Arab Emirates is expected to record a CAGR of 6.7% to reach AED 183.2 billion by 2024. The residential construction industry in value terms increased at a CAGR of 6.7% during 2015-2019. The commercial building construction market in value terms is expected to record a CAGR of 9.1% over the forecast period.

Saudi Arabia plans to spend US\$1.1 trillion on infrastructure projects alone in the next 20 years. The construction market is expected to register a CAGR of more than 8% over the forecast period, 2020-2025.

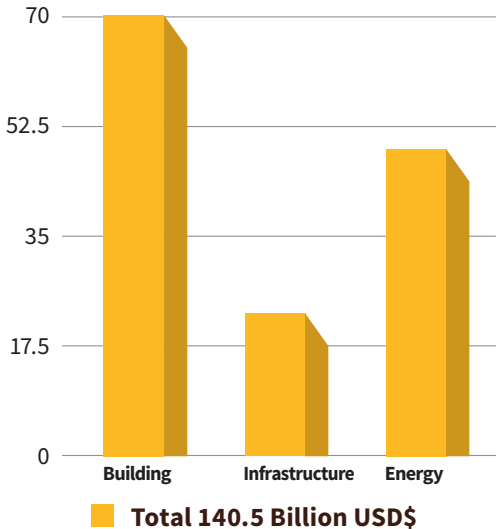
Kuwait aims to increase the country's revenue fourfold, going from US\$43.6 billion in 2017 to S\$164 billion by 2035. This strategy is focusing on the development of transport infrastructure, commercial buildings, health-care infrastructure, industrial facilities, water distillation facilities and renewable energy projects.

Oman plans to diversify into logistics, tourism and manufacturing, as well as improve public services and infrastructure with about US\$177 billion worth of projects planned or underway.

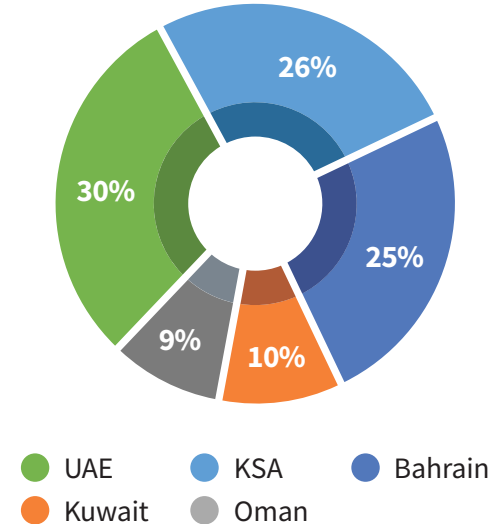
GCC construction contracts awarded by industry (Year 2019)



The GCC construction market is poised to grow with \$1tn construction and transport projects worth planned or under construction.

A number of mega projects were announced in Saudi Arabia, UAE and Oman in 2020 aiming long-term transformations in lines with the region's economic growth plans.

GCC construction contracts awarded by country (Year 2019)



New projects worth \$21 billion were announced in Q1 of 2020 with the largest contribution being made by the UAE with 59% market share followed by Oman.
